

The Student Resource Scheme (SRS) is designed to save parents money through the schools ability to bulk purchase. Parents who pay into the scheme do not need to buy items off a booklist.

If parents choose “NOT” to pay the SRS, then they are expected to provide the school with the items listed below as well as the limited items on the schools booklists which can be found on the school website. Pallara State School has a relatively low cost book list and SRS when compared to surrounding schools.

All students who attend Pallara State School will have access to the core curriculum taught in classes regardless of SRS payment; **however, student use of some items below will be limited and restricted if they have not bought into the SRS.** The cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of a student at a state school is met by the state. However, a parent is directly responsible for providing their child with other resources for use at school.

Participation in the Scheme is voluntary, and no obligation is placed on a parent to participate. However, all parents must return the mandatory Education Queensland Student Resource Scheme form to indicate your intention to participate or not and return it to the school office as soon as possible. No invoices will be issued unless the form is signed and returned to school regardless of participation or not.

The table below outlines the savings to families if they pay the cost of the SRS: \$130.00
